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## 2025 JUVARE USERS CONFERENCE TRAINING

**DAY 3 & 4 – JANUARY 16TH & 17TH, 2025**

### **CORES Track**

CORES RMS 2-day training equips participants to manage user profiles, registration, alerting, deployment, and administrative tasks, including organizational and recipient management, with the ability to generate reports. CORES HAN training similarly focuses on user profile, registration, alerting, and administrative features on the CORES HAN site, with a focus on organization and recipient management and report generation.

### **EMSuite Track**

The three-part training course over 2-days, provides eICS instruction on constructing emergency management plans, implementing emergency management best practices and training, EMResource training focused on facilitating communication between medical response teams and healthcare providers by monitoring healthcare assets, specialty services, and emergency department capacity, and the EMTrack segment focuses on training end-users to utilize the solution to track persons in an array of scenarios, including mass casualty incidents, evacuations, event medical tent operations, and vaccination clinics.

### **EMSuite Admin Track**

This 2-day training provides comprehensive instruction on administering and managing the eICS, EMResource, and EMTrack systems, covering user management, system customization, data tracking, and reporting. Participants will engage in interactive sessions to optimize these platforms for their organization's specific needs, ensuring readiness for both emergency and non-emergency situations.

### **Crisis Track Essentials**

*Training is one day only and held on Thursday, Jan. 16th.* Training presents comprehensive instruction on administering, planning, and executing disaster field operations using Crisis Track. Participants will learn mobile workflows for damage assessments, manage disaster operations in real-time, and gain the skills needed to administer and secure their Crisis Track accounts.

### **WebEOC Bootcamp**

This 2-day course combines presentations and hands-on exercises to educate students how to perform essential client setup tasks, basic board building in DesignStudio, and methods for administering WebEOC within their agency.

### **WebEOC Advanced Board Building Course**

This 2-day Advanced WebEOC training course provides hands-on, onsite instruction in board building, covering skills such as implementing board tags, conditional field sets, expressions, view links, and embedded maps, along with modifying actions, permissions, and board resources. Participants will gain practical experience in enhancing and customizing WebEOC boards through comprehensive exercises on all covered topics. *Must complete WebEOC Bootcamp as a prerequisite to scheduling.*
